



The Scacciadiavoli

Scacciadiavoli (from scacciare – to banish, and diavoli – devils) winery was founded in 1884 by Prince Ugo Boncompagni Ludovisi as an advanced oenological complex. After being bought by Amilcare Pambuffetti in 1954, his sons continued the activities and in 2000, his grandchildren decided to take the oldest winery of its kind in the area into their own hands.

While preserving the historical structures, extensive renovations were undertaken to introduce modern machinery and technologies. The winery is situated on a hill and the production takes place by gravity-flow in a vertical building on four levels, one of which is below ground.

Despite never stopping production since its inception, the renovations in 2000 marked a renewed passion for Scacciadiavoli.

The farm resides in the heart of the Frascati area, where for millennia the cultivation of the vine has been a part of Art, good living, and excellent gastronomy, in an unspoiled environment just a few kilometers from Rome. Founded in 1967 by Dr. Berardino Santarelli in Agro Pontino valley, 50km south of Rome. The estate pioneered viticulture in a previously uncharted wine region through an extensive research project launched in 1985.

Their 180-hectare vineyard employs cordon training systems, focusing on varieties suited to the maritime-influenced climate.

The research project, conducted with leading Italian viticultural institutes, led to EU authorization for "new recommended varieties" in Latina province from 1990, including Syrah, Petit Verdot, Sauvignon, and Chardonnay.

Current winemaker Paolo Tiefenthaler oversees production of 22 products: seven whites, seven reds, one rosé, one late harvest wine, three grappas, and olive oil.



The PRO.VI.MA

In the heart of Matelica, a tale as ancient as the Picentes tombs unfolds at the PRO.VI.MA Winery. A history rooted in over 2000 years of viticulture, this winery bears witness to the enduring relationship between its unique terroir and the verdant vines of Verdicchio.

Established in 1932, amidst a turbulent political era, the PRO.VI.MA cellar was positioned near the train station, symbolizing a nexus of tradition and commerce, as grapes journeyed by rail from vine to vat. Known in its earlier days as the 'Enopolio' or 'Centrale del Vino di Matelica,' this winery, which once swelled with 40,000 hectolitres of wine in the 1950s and '60s, now honors a commitment to quality over quantity, echoing the region's rich history while meeting contemporary tastes.

Today, as new and young vineyards join the cooperative, the PRO.VI.MA Winery remains a living testament to the deep-rooted passion of Matelica's wine producers - a legacy bottled with every harvest, authentic and ever-enduring.

Ippolito 1845

Established in 1845, Ippolito is Calabria's oldest operating winery, now in its fifth generation of family ownership. Their 100-hectare estate spans coastal plains and hillsides in Cirò Marina, with key vineyard sites in Feudo and Difesa Piana.

The estate pioneered modern winemaking in Calabria during the 1920s when Don Vincenzo introduced the region's first underground stone fermentation tanks and chestnut aging barrels. In the 1940s, Ippolito became Calabria's first estate to bottle their wines, using Piedmontese-style bottles for their Riservas - a tradition they maintain.

Their breakthrough came in 1989 with Colli del Mancuso Cirò Riserva, Calabria's first singlevineyard wine. The estate played a crucial role in establishing the Cirò DOC regulations in 1969, which formalized the use of Gaglioppo for red and rosé wines and Greco Bianco for whites. Current production focuses exclusively on indigenous varieties, with 15 different wines exported across four continents.

2,500-square-meter underground barrel cellar combines traditional aging methods with modern temperature control. Recent developments include collaborative research on Gaglioppo clonal selection with the University of Bari and the implementation of sustainable vineyard practices.

The estate's original vineyards lie between Rome and Naples in the historic Ager Falernus region, on volcanic-calcareous soils near Mount Roccamonfina.

Since 2000, the second generation (Salvatore and Maria-Ida Avallone) expanded to include vineyards in Benevento (Tenuta Rocca dei Leoni) and Irpinia (Tenute di Alta Villa). The estate is notable for identifying and preserving pre-phylloxera Falanghina, Aglianico, and Piedirosso biotypes through collaboration with the University of Naples.

Their top vineyards, Caracci (Falanghina) and Camarato (Aglianico/Piedirosso), contain 50-60 year old vines.

Currently led by brothers Alessandro (enologist) and Alberto (agrotechnician), the winery specializes in traditional Piedmontese varieties: Barbera, Nebbiolo, Grignolino, Dolcetto, Arneis, and Cortese, with emphasis on Barbera d'Asti.

Their flagship Barbera "L'Armatore" (The Shipowner) commemorates their historical connection to Corsiglia.

Founded in 1969 in the Piave river region, San Martino Vini evolved from a multi-crop farm to a specialized wine producer. Their vineyards stretch between the Piave River and the UNESCO Heritage hills of Conegliano and Valdobbiadene.

The estate manages complete production from vineyard to bottle at their facility in Visnà di Vazzola. Notable technical aspects include a modern sterile bottling system that minimizes sulfite use through reduced oxygen contact.

The winery combines traditional methods with technological innovation, focusing on both sparkling wine production and still wines from indigenous varieties.

They maintain historical "belussera" trained vines, a local system developed in Vazzola in the late 19th century.

Casa Vinicola D'Angelo

Established in the 1930s (with first wines exhibited in 1924), Casa Vinicola D'Angelo is a cornerstone of Basilicata's wine heritage, now in its fourth generation under siblings Erminia and Rocco D'Angelo.

The estate manages 25 hectares across two distinct vineyard sites: Barile (450-500m elevation, volcanic soils, vines 20-45 years old) and Maschito (400m elevation, marl-clay soils with calcarenite, vines 30-80 years old).

Both sites are planted at 4,000 vines per hectare using Guyot training. The winery was instrumental in establishing Aglianico del Vulture DOC in 1971 and began international exports in 1976.

Current production is 85% export-focused, primarily to USA, Canada, Germany, Switzerland, and Japan.

Operating across seven distinct estates in Sicily, Firriato manages three distinct viticultural zones: mountain (Etna), hillside (Trapani countryside), and maritime (Favignana island).

Their flagship Etna property, Cavanera, features pre-phylloxera vineyards certified through dendrochronological and genomic analysis, with vines up to 150 years old growing on volcanic sand. The estate maintains extensive holdings across Trapani (Baglio Sorìa, Borgo Guarini, Dagala Borromeo, Pianoro Cuddìa, and Giudeo) and a unique coastal vineyard on Favignana.

Notable for their research into historic vine varieties, including the preservation of pre-phylloxera Nerello Mascalese clones and unknown genotypes through an experimental vineyard program.

Located in Rovereto di Gavi in the historic Gavi DOCG zone, La Fontanassa occupies a 16thcentury fortified farmhouse with documented vineyard cultivation dating to 1634.

The estate encompasses 90 hectares, with 43 hectares of south and southwest-facing vineyards planted at 290-330 meters elevation on clay soils with stones and iron-rich sand.

The Gemme family has owned the property since 1921, with brothers Marco and Roberto initiating commercial wine production in 1988.

Vineyards are Guyot-trained, focusing primarily on Gavi DOCG production alongside other regional wines.

Colle di Maggio

Established in the 1960s in Velletri, Colle di Maggio cultivates vineyards and olive groves on the volcanic soils of Colli Albani, at elevations between 150-300 meters.

The estate practices organic viticulture, employing both spurred cordon and Guyot training systems at 4,500 vines per hectare.

Yields are strictly controlled: 1.5 kg per plant for reds and 2 kg for whites. Their winemaking approach combines traditional and modern vessels including wood (both large and small), cement tanks, and ceramic amphorae.

The estate produces both international and Italian varieties, with a historical connection to artists Giorgio de Chirico and Mario Schifano who found inspiration on the property




